SITE IMPROVEMENT PRIORITIES 2020

This year we continue to consolidate the learning around Reading and embed our agreements around Running Records, Guided Reading and Phonics. Teachers will be engaged in professional learning with Stephen Graham both off site and at school. Targeted learning around the Balanced Reader and how to plan an effective literacy block will focus heavily. We will expand our phonics with deeper understanding around phonemic and phonological awareness.

Staff will also begin the exciting learning journey around the Berry Street Model. The learning will occur over 4 Pupil Free days in 2020 and 2021. With a focus on Trauma informed practice this will support our work on improving engagement in learning across the school.

As these are specialist Professional Learning opportunities we have been unable to have flexibility in delivery dates. This has caused them both to fall in the same week instead of our usual term one and two pattern. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause but know that the impact for our students learning outcomes will be fabulous.





ROAD SAFETY

Thank you to all of the families that have been supporting safer roads. School Leaders and SAPOL have been providing advice to drivers on Holstein Dve and Uraidla Ave around safe driving and parking. No stopping

To 'stop' a vehicle means to stop and remain stationary for even a short period of time. You must not stop or park your vehicle in any area where a 'No Stopping' sign or continuous yellow edge line applies, even to pick up or set down passengers or goods.

No Parking You must not park your vehicle in an area where a "no Parking' sign applies, unless: you are dropping off or picking up passengers or goods you do not leave the vehicle unattended – that is, move more than 3 metres away. Dropping off and pick up must be as soon as possible, within two minutes. Please note: A No standing sign has the same meaning as a No Stopping sign
