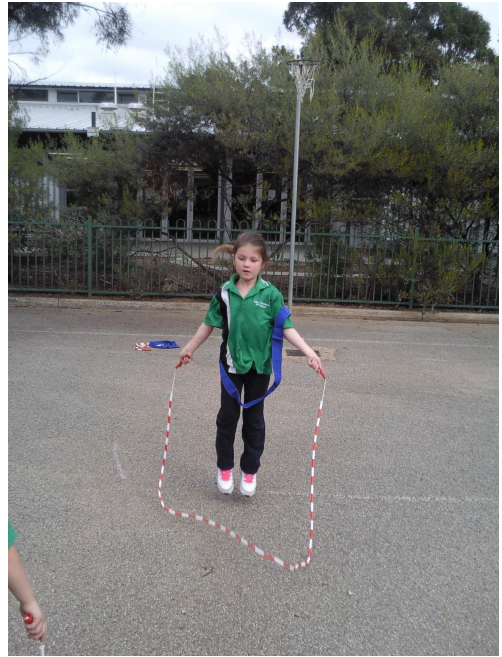


Bullying update term 2 2012

Saying No to Bullying!

- Safer Schools Survey for all students now finished 3-7 -Data being collated
- Planning and implementation of programs with individual teachers- child protection curriculum, You Can do it Program
- Student Leadership established for lunch time activities; football clinic, team games, skipping
- PE teachers helping student groups establish organised lunch times activities.
- From week 5 these activities will be displayed on a board or on doors of Blackwood
- Students have created an anti bullying Power Point as a class project - several classes have had this presentation presented by a small group of students– fact sheets, tattoos, wrist bands and stickers handed out to promote services that are available to assist e.g. Kids Help Line, Youth Beyond Blue



Ongoing:



- Restorative behaviour slips distributed and implemented by staff, leadership look into and deal with all reported incidences.
- Leadership presence in yard most recess and lunchtimes- Leadership in yard before and after school and end of lunch and recess.
- Individual behaviour plans developed involving input from the student, parents and staff.
- Incidences documented on EDSAS/ DUX
- Critical incidences completed where appropriate
- Bullying incidences reported to leadership followed up and appropriate actions taken e.g. restorative counselling
- Small groups of upper primary students targeted to become yard buddies – students mentored and trained to help room 32 students access mainstream yard play, new reception students to transition into school life.
- New staff attending training and development in behaviour management.
- Wave 3 students identified and ISBM involvement in establishing pro active strategies including ongoing reviews with parent and teacher involvement.
- Work with all staff to ensure consistent approaches to handling bullying incidences occurring in and out of the yard.
